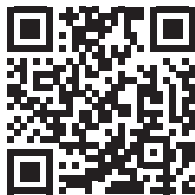

UNDERSTANDING LAMBPLAN MATERNAL ASBVS

BWT: Birth Weight (kg) - Rams with more negative BWT ASBVs produce lambs which are lighter at birth.
(BWT ASBVs estimate the genetic difference between animals in live weight at birth)

PWT: Post Weaning Weight (kg) - Rams with more positive WT ASBVs produce progeny that grow quicker and are heavier at a certain age, WT ASBVs are reported at weaning (WWT), post weaning (PWT), yearling (YWT), hogget (WT ASBVs estimate the genetic difference between animals in live weight at a given age)

PFAT: Post Weaning Fat Depth (mm) - Rams with more negative FAT ASBVs produce progeny that are leaner. FAT is reported at post weaning (PFAT), yearling (YFAT) and hogget (HFAT) ages.
(FAT ASBVs estimates the genetic difference between animals in GR fat depth)

PEMD: Post Weaning Eye Muscle Depth (mm) - Rams with more positive ASBVs for EMD will produce progeny that have more muscle, independent of weight, and a higher lean meat yield. EMD is reported at post weaning (PEMD), yearling (YEMD) and hogget (HEMD) ages.
(EMD ASBVs estimate the genetic difference between animals in eye muscle depth at the C site)

NLW: Number of Lambs Weaned (%) - Rams with more positive NLW ASBVs will sire daughters that wean a higher percentage of lambs.
(NLW ASBVs estimate the genetic difference between animals for the number of lambs weaned at each lambing opportunity)

BLX: Border Leicester Cross Index - The BLX index is for a first cross operation where maternal sires are joined to Merino dams, with the first cross female offspring then used in prime lamb systems joined to terminal sire rams. The index favours high early growth animals with good reproduction.

For your information please give due consideration to help with the productive life of your purchases:

- Wattle Farm recommends you take out Insurance Cover for your Stud or flock rams for the next 6 months as rams are susceptible to injury and death in this period.
- Your new ram(s) are better placed in a paddock away from other rams and ewes until joining where he can be feed well and looked after right up until joining.
- Lupins are a very good supplement around 6 weeks from joining and a proven method of increasing semen quality semen is manufactured six weeks prior to use.
- Rams tend to work much better with a shorter fleece so shearing should be considered which will consequently limit the potential for flystrike and grass seed issues
- Remember before sending your rams out to work, check teeth, check stones and check feet and make sure all are in excellent order.
- Your new ram is best placed with mature ewes and should not be overworked as he is your investment for future years to come.
- Every time you have your rams in the yards check them thoroughly to ensure a long productive life to get the best out of them.
- Drench your rams and maintain 7 in 1 vaccinations.
- Take care of your Wattle Farm purchases as they will take care of you.

NUTRITIONAL MANAGEMENT OF YOUR NEW RAM

We encourage purchasers of stud and flock rams to discuss the post sale management of your new ram's nutrition with us.

- Should their diet include hay or grain we believe that a protein level should not exceed 12% and a level closer to 10% would be better.
- Good quality cereal have will provide enough roughage especially when a 100 grams of lupins every other day is included in the ration.
- Over feeding with a high protein diet can lead to lower semen quality and can result in infertility which can take at least six weeks and quite often longer to reverse.
- Adequate shade prior to and including mating also assists in maintaining semen quality. An extended period of heat (i.e A week in the high 30s) and also reduce semen quality.
- As well as diet the shedding of stud rams can also provide a risk to semen quality if ventilation is poor and especially if there is a build up of manure below grating. Excessive ammonia buildup has the same effect on semen quality as high protein diets.

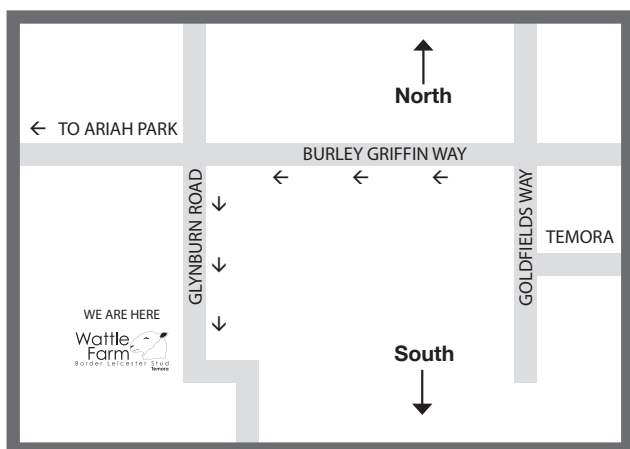

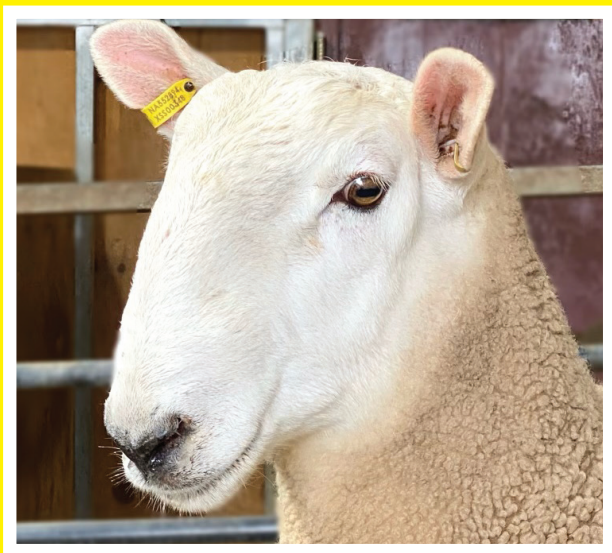
